## OUTREACH FOOD BASKET MINISTRY

*"Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food..."*  
~ *Mathew 25:37*

The **Outreach Food Basket Ministry** is the oldest Outreach ministry at St. Stephen's. While what we give out and how we interact with those we serve has changed over the years, especially this year, our basic ministry of feeding the hungry hasn't changed. We receive names of families/individuals in need from the Oak Ridge Resource Center and from parishioners. This year we served 26 families and individuals and 4 Hope House units. In the recent past, we have given out baskets four times a year and we give out various things during the Winter distribution such as Christmas gift bags, gloves, socks, hats, and calendars. Books are usually given out during the Fall and Winter distribution.

In the early months of this year we shopped for food and nonfood items; some of you donated items in the shopping carts or donated money (which we accept year round). Then, on March 14<sup>th</sup> we distributed the "baskets". This was a time of fellowship not just with those who helped but with our sponsored families. On May 30<sup>th</sup> and September 26<sup>th</sup>, we distributed Aldi gift cards (the amount varied from \$100 to \$150 based on family size); each family/unit drove up to the church drive thru; gloved and masked volunteers handed them the envelope. The volunteers said the families are joyful. On December 5<sup>th</sup>, we will be distributing a Christmas card with an Aldi gift card as well as a \$25 Walmart gift card for each of the 68 children on our list (that we suggest be used for gifts or other necessities). We are also giving the families a wall calendar that can be used by the parents or their children. Please keep our families and those of us who serve this ministry in your prayers.

## CARE MINISTRY BEGINS THIS MONTH!

On **December 13, 2020**, at the Sunday morning worship services, we will celebrate the beginning of a new parish-wide ministry. The goal of CARE – which stands for **Connecting And REconnecting** – is to ensure that each person at St. Stephen's knows they are remembered and valued. A team of 25 trained CARE callers will each be contacting a number of parish families and individuals every month, simply to "check in." CARE calls will complement Bailey's ministry by helping identify situations where more parish help might be welcome. CARE phone calls will also help identify opportunities to celebrate joyous occasions, or just be times to talk and get to know some of our fellow parishioners a little better.

In a week or two, each parish family will be receiving a letter that provides more information about CARE.
