RISE AND SHINE...A BIT EARLIER

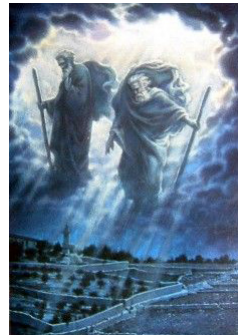
