CLEARFORK LEARNING CAMP



Every weekday from 11:45 to 12 noon.


Come as you are. Prayers are offered, scripture is read, and the bell is rung, with the hope that peace may ring out in our hearts and around the world.

Fr. Ashton will lead a short book study this Sunday, May 22, 2022 at 11:30 in the Pollard Room. He will discuss Chapter 2 of <u>Being Christian: Baptism</u>, Bible, Eucharist, Prayer by The Rt.

Rev. Rowan Williams. In this short, simple, yet beautifully written book, Archbishop Williams explores what he sees as the four fundamentals in the Christian life. It is no secret that over the centuries different

expressions of the Christian faith have developed different understandings of baptism, Scripture, Eucharist, and prayer; however, he says that these four basic elements have remained constant and essential for the majority of those who call themselves Christian.
