## Welcome Back from London



## From Last Week's E-News

### **Reminder: New Building Access Measures**

On July 1, 2023, we implemented new building access control measures:

- The building will be kept locked, except during service arrival times. During these times, entry will be monitored.
- Ring doorbells have been placed at doorways. These can be used during office hours to assess visitors prior to building entry.
- All groups using the building must keep all doors locked. Doors cannot be left unlocked or unattended.
- Unfamiliar visitors must be accompanied while inside our facility and are not allowed to bring backpacks or similar items into the building.
